
Nouns Ending in the Suffix -ation



This week, we are going to look again at adding the suffix -ation to verb root words to create nouns.

Can you remember the rules about adding **-ation**?



If the root word doesn't end in **'e'**, then no change is needed when **-ation** is added,

e.g. inform + ation = information

If the root word ends in **'e'** (but not 'ate'), then drop the **'e'** when **-ation** is added,


e.g. imagine + ation = imagination.


If the root word ends in 'ate', then drop the 'ate' when -ation is added,

e.g. educate + ation = education.

Don't forget the rules about adding the suffix **-ation**.






