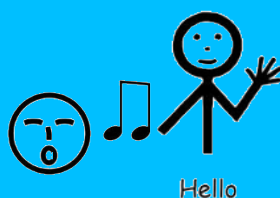

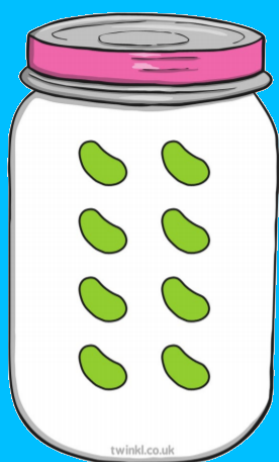
You all need a whiteboard and pen:

Each time Miss Richards gets a ball in the bucket, she will make a mark on the board. You then write the number on your board.

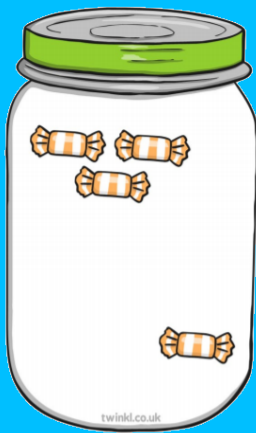

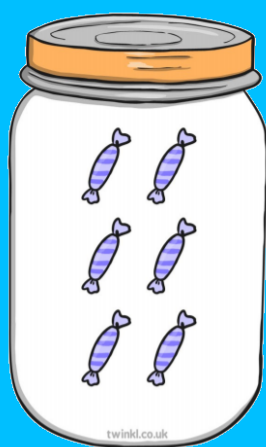

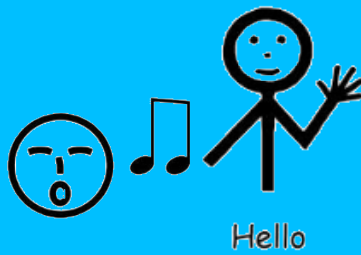
