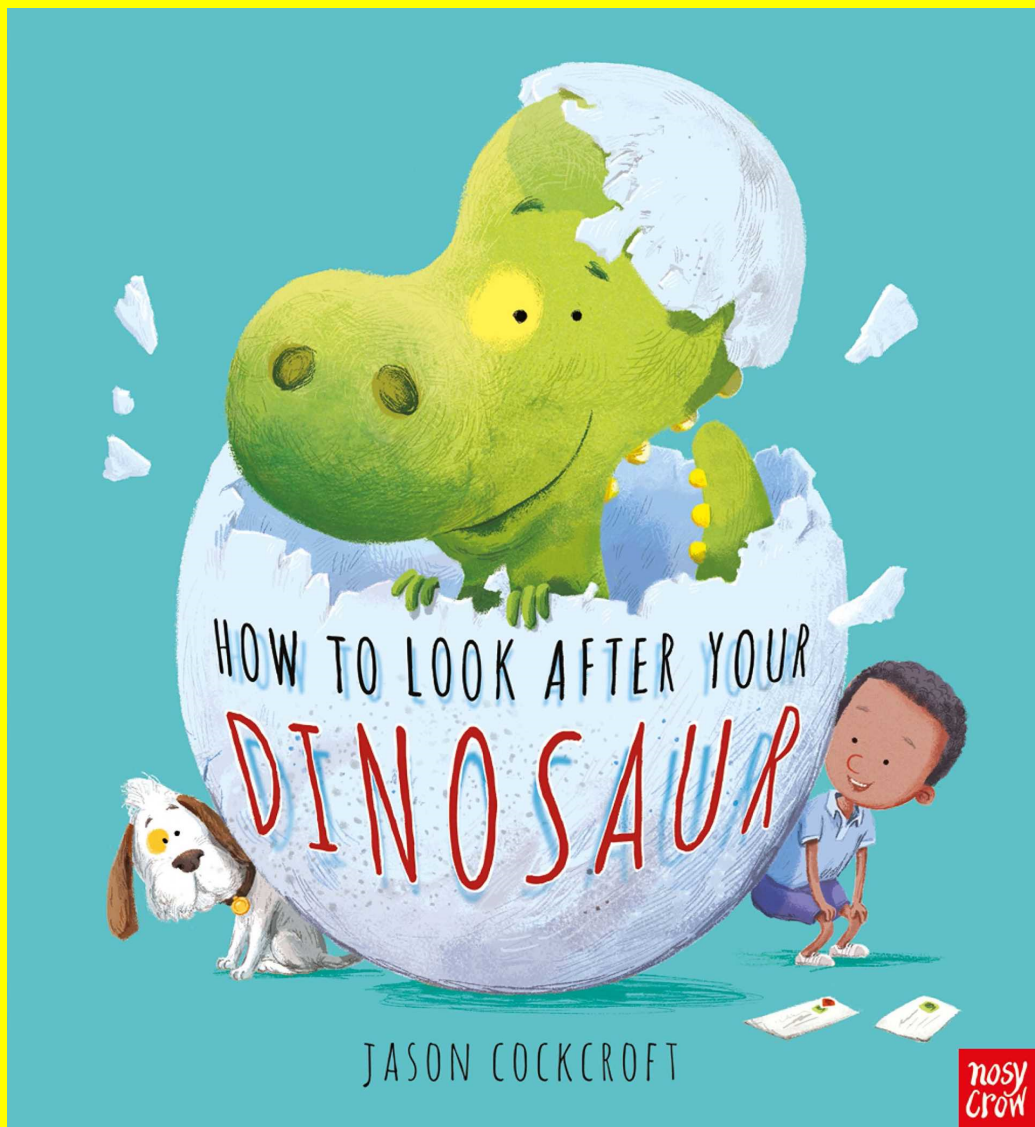
How would I look after my dino pet to keep it happy and healthy?

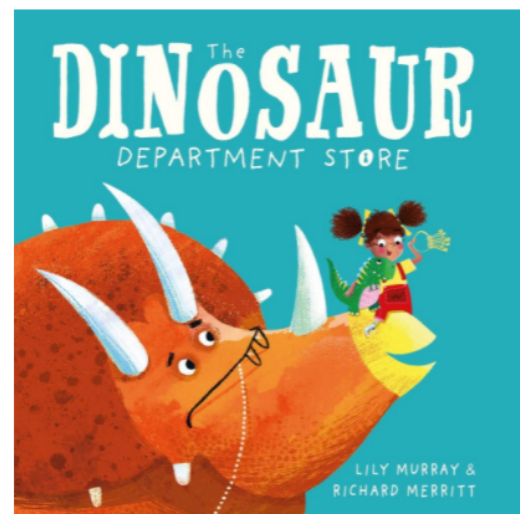

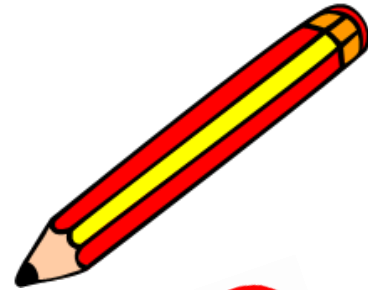

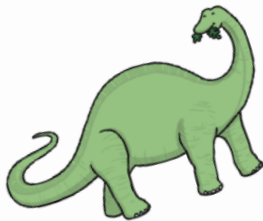
