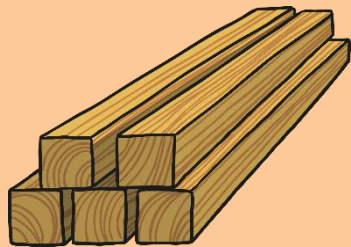
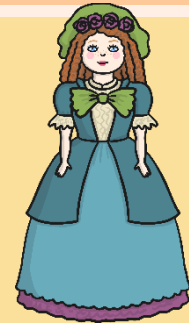
Time Vocabulary

In the past, lots of toys were made from wood and metal, but now most toys are made from plastic.



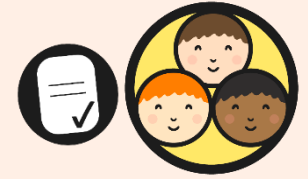
Toy Box Muddle!
